Lent is a season of soulsearching and repentance. It is a season for reflection and taking stock. Lent originated in the very earliest days of the Church as a preparatory time for Easter, when the faithful reeducated themselves and when converts were instructed in the faith and prepared for baptism. By observing the forty days of Lent, the individual Christian imitates Jesus' withdrawal into the wilderness for forty days. The ancient church that wrote, collected, canonized, and propagated the

New Testament observed Lent, believing it to be commanded by the apostles. Just as we prepare for big events in our personal lives, such as a wedding or commencement, Lent invites us to make our hearts ready for remembering Jesus' passion and celebrating Jesus' resurrection. The Christian journey that began in Advent as we waited for the coming Christ-child now continues as we move toward the cross. Each Lenten Sunday, beginning March 1, our worship service will include a symbolic representation of some aspect of our journey. The journey toward the cross is not an easy journey, and it can seem dark and troublesome. But we also know that we do not make the journey alone. You are invited to join us each week for worship as we enter into this important part of the Christian year, faithfully following the path that will lead us to Maundy Thursday, Good Friday, and the celebration of Easter.


