Items Needed for Each Child

- 1 three-ring binder (1 1/2 inch size)
- 1 one-subject spiral notebook (wide or college ruled)
- 1 black and white composition book
- 4 pocket folders with or without brads (solid colors)
- 1 pack of 3x5 inch index cards
- 1 pack of pencils
- 1 pack of pens (blue or black)
- 2 yellow highlighters
- 1 box of crayons (24 pack)
- 1 box markers
- 1 box colored pencils
- 1 small pencil sharpener
- 1 pair scissors (pointed or blunt; Fiskar or similar brand)
- 4-6 glue sticks
- 1 pack pencil-top erasers
- 1 pencil zipper pouch (to fit in 3-ring binder)
- 1 pocket-size hand sanitizer

NOTE: If you are interested in donating a backpack instead of supplies, please make sure that it is sturdy and large enough to hold notebooks and textbooks.
